In 2011, the State of Florida enacted preemption measures designed to restrict local authority from regulating firearms and established penalties for the local governments that do attempt to restrict gun use. Subsequently, the Attorney General concluded that counties are prevented from enacting ordinances that prohibit the discharge of firearms “in the proximity to persons or property,” even when the ordinance is adopted for public health and safety purposes. Please join us to discuss gun laws as they relate to zoning ordinances. Several topics will include private gun ranges, backyard target practice, commercial indoor and outdoor ranges and hunting on private property.
